1. Year-Closure Matters

a) Year End Events

i. CCA Appreciation Day

Our CCA Appreciation Day is on Tuesday, 14 Nov 2017. We will be giving out the following awards:

ii. Grade-level Prize Presentations

Our Grade-level Prize Presentations for P1 to P5 students have been scheduled for **Wednesday, 15 Nov 2017**. We are not inviting parents to attend this event this year as there will be 80 to 100 awards to be given per level and we are unable to accommodate the number of parents and students in the school hall. We seek your understanding on this matter.

Please take note that **Wednesday, 15 Nov 2017** will be the last day of school for all P1-P5 students. All P1-P6 students will be dismissed at 1.45pm as usual.

iii. Parent-Teacher-Meeting (PTM)

We will be having our P1 to P5 PTM Session on **Thursday, 16 Nov 2017** from 8am-4.40pm. Teachers will be sharing with you information about your child's/ward's academic performance, learning progress, general conduct and holistic development. Your child's/ward's report book will also be issued to you during the meeting.

Please take note of the following points:

- i. Parents who drive may need to park their vehicles in the carparks of the neighbouring Joo Seng estate, as there are limited parking spaces within the school premises.
- ii. As teachers will be meeting with many parents/guardians that day, queues are expected to form on the day. Your kind patience is sought in waiting for your turn. Parents/Guardians of each pupil will have at most 10 minutes with each Form or Subject Teacher. We seek your understanding in this matter. If further discussions are needed, the teacher will follow up with a telephone call on another day.
- iii. The timeslot 12pm-1pm on that day is set aside for the teachers' lunch and rest breaks. Teachers will not be meeting parents/guardians during this timeslot.
- iv. All Report Books are to be returned to school, signed, on **Tuesday, 2 Jan 2018**.

Please take note that **17 Nov 2017** will be the last day of school for **P6 students**. **All P6 students will be dismissed at 12pm.**

2. **Holiday Travel Plans**

For the Nov/Dec Holidays, parents of **ALL parents of P1 students** need to declare their travel plans of their P1 children regardless of travel intent. For other levels, parents need to declare the travel plans of their children only if their children intend to travel.

3. **Release of 2017 PSLE Results**

The date of release of the 2017 Primary School Leaving Examination has tentatively been scheduled to fall on **24 or 27 November 2017**. Parents and P6 students are advised to watch out for media announcements on the actual release date and time.

P6 students are to come in their **full school uniform** when collecting their result slips. P6 students will be attended to first, before parents who come in their children's place to collect the result slips.

4. **2018 School Year Schedule**

The new school year will commence on **Tuesday, 2 January 2018**. We enclose the weekly schedule for the year 2018 for your reference. We hope that the early dissemination of the information will support you in planning after-school care and activities for your child/ward.

All students are expected to be in school and report to their Form Teacher for attendance-taking **by 7.40am**. Students who report after 7.40am will be considered late for school. The flag-raising ceremony will commence at 7.40am and the first lesson for the day will start at 7.45am.

Once details are confirmed in the new school year, teachers will be issuing consent forms to students involved in remedial/supplementary lessons or CCA sessions.

Drop-Off by Parents/Guardians

- Between 7am and 7.40am, parents/guardians are to drive into our school premises and drop off their child/ward at the school porch.


6. Appreciation & Happy Holidays
