
Dear Parents/Guardians,

2018 TERM 1 CALENDAR & LOGISTICAL MATTERS

We warmly welcome your children back to school. We would like to take this opportunity to wish you, your child/ward and your family a wonderful year ahead of good health, successful endeavours and joyous moments! We look forward to working hand-in-hand with you to make 2018 a fruitful year of learning and growth for your child/ward.

1. Pick-up Point after 2.30pm

As the Indoor Sports Hall is currently being constructed, we have negotiated with the developers to continue with the heavy construction after 2.30pm on school days. As a safety precaution, our students will be advised to leave the school from the entrance and side gate nearer Cedar Girl's Secondary School. The current exit shown in the diagram below will also be closed and the current entrance will serve as exit and entrance into the school premises after 2.30pm. Heavy construction work on the Indoor Sports Hall is expected to end by the end of Semester 1. We will keep you informed of the progress and thank you for your patience and understanding.



2. Safety and Well-being of our Students in 2018

For the safety and well-being of our students, the school will continue to implement the following measures in 2018. We hope that these measures will also help our students learn and gain independence.

a) Except for the first two days of each school year, please note that all parents are NOT allowed to come into the school without making prior appointments during curriculum time. All visitors must report to the Guard Post. The security guards will then issue a Visitor's Pass and accompany him/her to the General Office for the intended purpose.

The Visitor's Pass must be visibly displayed at all times during your visit in the school. Visitors are not to wander around the school premises or to the classroom block unaccompanied. Visitors without Visitor's Passes will be questioned by the school staff or security guards on their business in school.

b) As there is limited space and food sold at the canteen, <u>parents are NOT allowed to buy food or eat in the school canteen at all times</u>. Please do not occupy the seats in the canteen during lunch time as they are reserved for students and staff.

3. Opening Week Programme

In the opening week, we are focusing time and energy to set a positive school tone for a great start to the year ahead. The following are some learning activities we have prepared for students.

- The Form Teacher will be spending time with his/her Form Class to build rapport, establish ground rules and expectations, and set targets and goals. The Form Teacher will also conduct activities for students to get to know one another.
- CCA Option Exercise will be held throughout the first week of school. CCAs are optional for F1 and P2 students. P3 to P5 students are strongly encouraged to choose at least 1 CCA. P6 students are automatically placed in their previous CCA(s). Parents/Guardians are encouraged to take this time to choose a suitable CCA together with their child/ward.
- The school's Student Care Centre run by Big Heart Student Care commences operation on 2
 January 2018. You would have been contacted by the personnel from the centre by the end of 2017 if you have successfully registered your child.

4. Temperature Taking Exercise on Friday, 5 January 2018

We will be conducting a temperature taking exercise on Friday, 5 January 2018.

- Please join us in reminding your child/ward to have his/her ODT with him/her every day and to
 use it to monitor his/her own health. Please discourage your child from sharing his/her ODT with
 others.
- Every P1 student will be issued with a new personal ODT prior to the Temperature Taking Exercise.
 This is a one-off provision. Teachers will also teach P1 students on the use and care of the ODT.

6. Weekly School Schedule for 2018

• Remedial/Supplementary Lessons: The school conducts remedial/supplementary lessons to provide academic support and enrichment. All levels have assigned days and timeslots for these lessons, as shown in the Weekly Schedule.

Please note the following:

- The supplementary lessons for P6 will start in Term 1 Week 3 on Monday, 15 January 2018...
- The remedial lessons for P2-P5 will also start in Term 1 Week 3 on Monday, 15 January 2018.
- The **remedial lessons for our P1 students** will commence in **Term 2 Week 1**. More details will be given at a later date.
- Co-Curricular Activities (CCA): CCA is an integral part of the Cedar school experience, serving to
 nurture interests, develop talent, forge friendships among students and cultivate a sense of
 entrepreneurial dare.
 - CCA day will be on Tuesdays.
 - CCAs that are held on Mondays and Wednesdays will start only after Supplementary Remedial sessions.
 - For CCAs that are held on Thursdays and Fridays, parents will need to arrange for the transport arrangement after CCA ends.
 - CCA sessions will start on Term 1, Week 4 (Tuesday, 23 January 2018).
 - Some CCAs will start their training sessions earlier for selected students to gear them up for external competitions.
 - Parents/Guardians are required to give their consent by signing the consent form before their child/ward can attend their CCA sessions.
